Training

The GHG inventory and action analysis are just the beginning. For communities looking to internalize their capacity to conduct GHG inventories, UNPREDICTABLEcity will train city staff to utilize the **Climate Action for Urban Sustainability** (CURB) tool and how to source data for the analysis.

For training, we recommend two day-long sessions. The first to focus on the tool and the second to focus on data collection. We're happy to tailor these virtual workshops to your city's needs.

Cost to Cities

Training is an optional service provided to PCFO member cities at \$65 per hour, or around \$500 for a full-day training.
